Dear Parents/Guardians,

In recent weeks, I have received a number of complaints from local residents with regards to illegal and unsafe driving and parking practices around our school.

I know the start and end of the school day can be hectic for parents and, in particular, that finding parking can be a challenge. However, as I'm sure you would agree, public safety – especially the safety of our children – is and should be everyone's top priority. With that in mind, I would encourage you to drive within the school zone speed limit and respect the pavement markings in and around our neighbourhood. You may also want to consider dropping your child(ren) a little further away from the school and letting them walk the remainder of the way. The Delta Police Department traffic section will be conducting ongoing enforcement in the area.

I have attached a reminder of some helpful road safety tips for you to share with your child(ren), along with the rules of the road for drivers.

## Tips for Crossing Roads Safely

- Cross where it's safe. If there is a designated crossing, use it, even if it means taking a detour.
- Stop before stepping into a road, driveway or lane.
- Look in all directions. Look left-right-left and over the shoulder for vehicles that may be turning.
- Listen for approaching vehicles that aren't visible but could be coming from a driveway or around a corner.
- Make eye contact with drivers so you know they see you and they know you see them. Remember that unless a driver is looking directly at you, they may not see you.
- Check that all vehicles are completely stopped before stepping into the road. Be certain there are no vehicles passing stopped vehicles – especially trucks or vans.
- Obey all traffic signs.
- Walk, don't run across the street, roadway or lane. Keep looking for approaching vehicles as you cross. Look left-right-left and over your shoulder.
- Don't wear headphones when crossing streets. Remember, you have to Stop, Look and Listen.
- Don't jaywalk. Cross only at corners or marked crosswalks.

## Rules of the Road for Drivers

- Travel 30 km/hr or less near schools from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on school days.
- Obey all "no parking" and "no stopping" signs in school and park zones. Parked vehicles reduce visibility and are a traffic hazard for children. Also, please do not double park.
- Stop for pedestrians at crosswalks and intersections. Wait until pedestrians have crossed the street before proceeding and never pass a vehicle that has stopped for pedestrians. Please do not park across crosswalks.
- Do not pass a school bus with its red lights flashing.
- Be alert at all times. Make eye contact with pedestrians so they know you see them. When children are present, please be extra careful.
