Dear Seaquam families,

As a follow up to the survey that was sent out yesterday, we wanted to provide more details about next week's schedule. As of yet, this plan has not been approved by the Ministry of Education and is subject to change. In short, we will have Tutorials in the morning and continue with distance/remote learning in the afternoon. There will not be any new instruction being provided in these sessions and will only be supplementing the work that is being done in the remote learning environment. The schedule below provides everyone with an idea of next week's schedule.

It is also important to note that to ensure social distancing is possible in all classrooms, there will be limited spots to sign up for in each block with your child's current teachers. As a result, your child may have to be placed with a different teacher for support. We cannot exceed 20% of our total student population at any time in our school. For Seaquam Secondary, this is roughly 275 students or 4 students in each teacher's class.

As a reminder, the 3 student priorities – as set out by the Ministry of Education:

- Priority 1 – students of Essential Service Workers
- Priority 2 – students with ministry designations or are deemed vulnerable (these can include students who are struggling with remote learning)
- Priority 3 – all other students

We need to provide opportunities to priority 1 and 2 students prior to opening up opportunities for the general student population. The sign up for available spaces in classes will occur later this week once we have determined how many priority 1 and 2 students will be returning to us. Teachers will also be contacting students who they feel would benefit from the additional support and inviting them to return to school.
