

School Start Up Information

Hello Seaquam community,

We wanted to provide some additional information for you regarding school start up.

Daily Health Check

It is imperative for parents to go on to Parent Connect and read the "Daily Health Check" form and check the box that they agree to conduct the daily health check before sending their child to school each day. This is not optional for parents and is part of the Health Officer's requirement for students to return to school. **Parents must complete the form and acknowledge their responsibility for daily health checks prior to their child returning to school on September 10th.** This acknowledgement needs to be completed once. We ask everyone to complete this process.

Hybrid Classes

These classes will only effect students in grades 10-12 in session 2 classes. These classes are being set up because the session 1 learning group cannot be maintained into session 2. Students must physical distance, wear masks, or have barriers between them.

- Limited number of students for in class instruction
- Instruction for those students in class; other learning activities for those who are not in class, but are in self-directed study
- Students rotate into the in class instruction over a quarter
- Grades 10, 11, 12 – 1 learning group (morning session), 1 hybrid (afternoon session)

The organization of Hybrid classes in grades 10-12 in the afternoon session will be left to the teacher to manage where they will need to consider:

- the classroom space
- the number of students who can fit into your classroom space to make physical distancing possible to a maximum of 15 students
- Eg. 30 students in a class
 - 10 students can practice physical distancing in a given classroom space
 - 3 groupings of 10 students to rotate for in class instruction

Monday:	Group 1	in class	Groups 2 & 3 self-directed studies
Tuesday:	Group 2	in class	Groups 1 & 3 self-directed studies
Wednesday:	Group 3	in class	Groups 1 & 2 self-directed studies
Thursday:	Group 1	in class	Groups 2 & 3 self-directed studies
Friday:	Group 2	in class	Groups 1 & 3 self-directed studies

 - And so on for the 10-week quarter

Teachers will contact students regarding the organization of these classes before Monday's classes
