# Attendance



- ⊗ Regular and punctual attendance is *fundamental to success* at school. Students should always be in class, on time, unless there is a justifiable reason for absence: illness, field trips, emergency appointments, etc.
- ⊗ If a student is to be absent from school, a *parent* must contact the school by telephone or email as soon as possible to advise the school of the absence.
- ⊗ Want everyone to be on TIME.



# Injuries/Illness at School

- ⊗ If you become ill or get injured during class time, notify the classroom teacher who will assist you. If illness or injury occurs outside of the classroom, report to the office, or have someone notify a staff member or the office.
- ⊗ Seaquam is fortunate to have an outstanding “Student First Responders” (SFR) team. Our trained senior students are qualified to administer first aid until medical professionals attend to the student.

# School Parking

- Violators will lose parking privileges



# What is Flex?

- A 55-minute work period built into Seaquam's schedule on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Individualized learning time where students have control over what they work on and where.



# Expectations

- Flex is mandatory class time/instructional time.
- Attendance is mandatory and will be tracked, recorded and reported.
- Students must be in a learning space for Flex.
- Spaces are limited in classes you want to register for = DO IT EARLY!
