South Delta Baptist Church on Friday, June 23. Doors open around 6:15. Start time is around 7pm. There are limited number of tickets for families. Please read the message below:

On Friday, June 2nd we will be sending out each family a link to claim their two electronic tickets for the Commencement Event on June 23rd. Families will receive a link via the primary email listed in MyED. From there, families will be able to download and print a PDF of the ticket or add it to their digital wallet on their cellphone. In order to ensure that this step is as seamless as possible, we ask that all families ensure that their primary email address is up to date on MyED between now and June 2nd. Our office is available to help families log in and check your email details over the next three weeks. You are also welcome to complete this quick step on your own through MyED. If there are unclaimed tickets or additional tickets available, we will communicate with families after June 16th. The process will be outlined at that time.

Please note that these digital tickets may only be scanned once at the door. They work very similar to way that concert or movie tickets do. Families will need to organize the digital tickets among themselves after they have been sent to the primary address recipient.
