Attendance



- Regular and punctual attendance is *fundamental to success* at school. Students should always be in class, on time, unless there is a justifiable reason for absence: illness, field trips, emergency appointments, etc.
- If a student is to be absent from school, a *parent* must contact the school by telephone or email as soon as possible to advise the school of the absence.

Injuries/Illness at School

What is Flex?

- A 35-minute work period built into Seaquam's schedule on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Friday
- Individualized learning time where students have control over what they work on and where.



Flex Expectations

- Flex is mandatory class time/instructional time.
- Attendance is mandatory and will be tracked, recorded and reported.
- Students must be in a learning space for Flex.
