I hope that you will be able to join our music program in this special event as we welcome a guest ensemble to the concert- the Delta Concert Band (a wonderful local community band).

The concert begins at 7:00pm in the theatre and will feature the following ensembles: Concert Band, Jazz Band, Concert Choir, and Wind Ensemble. In this concert, the guest band- Delta Concert Band, will be performing at the concert and will also do a collaboration with our Wind Ensemble and Concert Choir for the first time having over 100 people on stage!

Admission is by donation at the door and that goes towards supporting the music program- we are currently looking to purchase much needed music stand carts to use for our music room and for concerts, as well as repairing of instruments.
