Yearbooks

Yearbooks will be given out on Friday, June 20 in Block A classes. A couple of things to remember – we do not have any additional books to sell. We are only giving out books to those that bought one earlier in the year and who have no outstanding fees. **If you have outstanding fees, they need to be paid off before you can get your yearbook.** Check the "Fees" tab in Parent Connect to see if you owe any money and/or have paid for a Yearbook. Avoid any confusion and delay by paying off your fees ASAP. Also, we do not give out yearbooks early. We are open all summer and you can come in then to get it.

Course Completion Days
